

HOW TO MAKE CHEW CARDS

Chew cards are a simple tool to help identify the presence of rats, mice, stoats, possums and hedgehogs.

Equipment

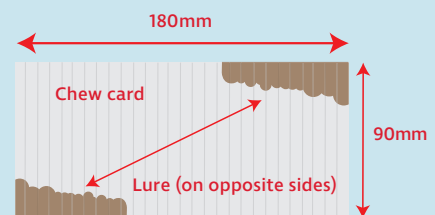
- 3mm thick corflute - old real estate signs are perfect
- A sharp craft knife
- A flat knife or paint scraper
- Smooth peanut butter (this is your lure)

Cut the cards

- Cut the corflute into rectangles (approximately 90mm by 180mm)
- Ensure the internal channels (flutes) run across the width of the card
- Cut the corflute accurately so the amount of lure in each card is the same

Apply lure

- Make a pile of approximately ten chew cards
- Get a full knife of peanut butter
- Hold the cards together and spread lure along **half** of each side (at opposite ends)
- Hold up the cards to check the lure is 12–20mm into the flutes
